## INTERNATIONAL SUMMER COURSE: A2-B1/B2

Up to eight courses from level A2 to B2 (European framework of reference). All course participants will take a standardized grading test.

### Classes:

Classes are held for four hours on weekday mornings, and there is a two-hour tutorial in the afternoon. We practice speaking and writing as well as grammar and vocabulary. Reading comprehension, intercultural general knowledge and everyday culture all play an important role alongside projects on subjects chosen by the students.

### Additional Activities:

The courses fee covers additional activities, including lectures and seminars on Germany, training in German speaking and reading, evenings at the movies, theater, music and literature events, a Swabian cookery course, sports events, tours of the town, as well as festivals and other events organized by the city of Tübingen. They round off the course, giving you a comprehensive picture of German language and culture.

### Excursions:

The tuition fee also includes two full-day excursions to places outside Tübingen.

### ECTS Credit Points

You can earn a maximum of 5 ECTS credit points in the International Summer Course.

### Who can take part?

The courses are open to students and graduates of all subjects, professionals from around the world, and anyone interested in German language and culture who meets the requirements.

Minimum age 18. Maximum number of participants: 120.

## 29th International Summer Courses Monday, August 5 - Saturday, August 31, 2013 Participation Requirements

Course dates: Monday, August 5 (CHECK-IN)  
to Saturday, August 31, 2013 (CHECK-OUT)

Tuition fee: € 595 for classes and tutorials, teaching materials, two excursions to nearby towns and countryside, most of the additional activities and for access to the University's computer pool.

Closing date for applications: June 28, 2013 or when courses are full. We recommend applying as soon as possible (from January 2, 2013). If you need to apply after the end of June, please contact us by phone or e-mail to find out if there are places still available.

Accommodation: We can reserve you a single room upon request. The rooms are in student halls of residence, with shared bathrooms and kitchens, and cost between € 330 and € 360 for the month. This sum includes help moving in and a monthly ticket for Tübingen city buses.

Food: You should reckon with costs of around € 300. Low-cost meals are available at the student cafeteria.

Health insurance: Please take out health insurance in your home country to cover you while you are in Germany. The tuition fee does not include insurance!

Cancellation: Should you cancel your registration after June 28, 2013, we will deduct a processing fee of €100 from the refund amount. Cancellations after July 12 will incur an additional deduction of up to € 300 for the room reservation.

## INTERNATIONAL SUMMER ACADEMY: B2-C2

Up to five courses from level B2 to C2 (European framework of reference). Classes are held for four hours on weekday mornings. Students practice communication and rhetoric as well as grammar, vocabulary, idioms, writing and correcting mistakes. Integrated project work is also a key part of the course. Afternoon work comprises a selection of modules on a variety of topics, allowing participants to use and improve their advanced language skills. The following modules are planned:

- | Economy and society
- | Intercultural Communication
- | Philosophy
- | Introduction to the German legal system
- | German History
- | Theology: inter-religious dialogue

### Additional Activities:

There is an interesting selection of activities on German society and culture offered in the afternoons and evenings, including seminars on literature and politics, movies, theater and sports. The cost of these events is included in your tuition fee.

### Excursions:

The tuition fee also includes two full-day excursions to places outside Tübingen.

### ECTS Credit Points

You can earn a maximum of 6 ECTS credit points in the International Summer Academy.
